

## Reopening of the Deutsche Kinemathek on May 14, 2020

**The Museum für Film und Fernsehen welcomes back its visitors as of May 14, 2020. Until June 14, 2020, we invite the public to view the Permanent Exhibition with free admission. The library and archives offer users special hours of service beginning on May 11, 2020.**

The health of our visitors and staff is very important to us. The Deutsche Kinemathek has taken all the necessary precautions to hinder the spread of the coronavirus. All areas of the building have been redesigned and equipped in accordance with the health and hygiene regulations now in place for public use. The maximum number of people that may be inside the museum at the same time is limited so that a minimum distance of 1.5 meters between each person can be maintained.

By mid-June, our special exhibitions *Burn Marks — Film Posters from a Salt Mine* and *Be Caligari! — The Virtual Cabinet*, as well as our Television Focus on documentary filmmaker Klaus Wildenhahn, will have gradually reopened. The duration of each of these special exhibitions has been extended through November 2, 2020.

Group visits, bookings of guided tours, film courses and workshops are not permitted to take place until further notice. On our website, Instagram account and Facebook channel we will continue to provide regular offers of virtual tours, presentations from the Kinemathek collections, tutorials for children and teens, as well as online views of the exhibitions.
